SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum #2-8, Risk Reduction Program

1. **Effective Date.** This policy letter remains in effect until superseded or rescinded.
2. **Scope.** This policy is applicable to all military units, commands, and tenant organizations serviced by the USAG Schweinfurt Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP).
3. **References.**
 - a. AR 600-85, Army Substance Abuse Program (ASAP), 02 December 2009
4. **Policy.** The Army's Risk Reduction Program (RRP) is designed to assist Commanders in identifying and reducing high risk factors.
 - a. Individuals providing data to the RRP Coordinator will submit data no later than the 10th of each month. The Health Promotion Council will discuss/analyze the data during the quarterly meeting for prevention and intervention strategies.
 - b. Monthly data will be provided to Commanders, furnishing a snapshot of their unit. The RRP Coordinator will be available to discuss the results and recommend solutions.
 - c. The Unit Risk Inventory (URI) is designed to screen for high risk behaviors and attitudes that compromise unit readiness. It will be administered to the unit on an annual basis. Deploying Soldiers will complete the Unit Risk Inventory (URI) Survey no later than 30 days prior to deployment. The Reintegration Unit Risk Inventory (R-URI) will be completed by all redeploying Soldiers within 60 to 120 days upon reintegration.
5. **Point of Contact.** POC is the Army Substance Abuse Program staff at DSN 354-1710.
