- x Car/window glass/mirrors
- x Pottery
- x Stone-ware

Cans

Do's

- ✓ Food/coffee cans
- ✓ Metal Frozen food containers
- ✓ Pie tins
- ✓ Small pieces of scrap metal
- ✓ Soda/beer cans (non-deposit)

Don'ts

- x Large metal objects (pots, pans)
- x Juice cartons
- x Metallic wrapping paper (coffee bags, candy wrappers etc.)

- ✓ Aluminum foil
- ✓ Cigarette butts & charcoal ashes (cold)
- ✓ Items With mixed content
- ✓ Candles
- ✓ Napkins
- ✓ Standard light bulbs

Household Hazardous



- ✓ Energy Saving Lamps / low-energy light bulbs
- ✓ Batteries
- ✓ Camera film/disposable cameras
- ✓ Cleaning agents
- ✓ Cosmetics, Deodorants
- ✓ Glue, Nail polish
- ✓ Oil, Medicine
- ✓ Paint, Perfume
- ✓ Shoe polish
- ✓ Solvents
