EFFECTIVE AUGUST 2012 FOR THE 2012 – 2013 SCHOOL YEAR

The Schweinfurt School Dress Code will be as follows:	Which means absolutely:
<p><u>LEG WEAR</u> Solid <u>any color</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Leg wear will be of one solid color ❖ Cotton/polyester/corduroy long pants (Dockers style) ❖ Cargo pants with pockets closed and empty ❖ Jumpers ❖ Skirts (knee length) or skirts ❖ Walking shorts (mid-thigh when sitting) ❖ Capri pants (mid-calf) 	<p><u>LEG WEAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> Nylon pants ➤ <u>NO</u> Zip-Apart pants ➤ <u>NO</u> Sagging or baggy pants ➤ <u>NO</u> Frayed pants, holes, embroidery, bling on pants ➤ <u>NO</u> Undergarments showing or protruding above waistband of pants ➤ <u>NO</u> Form fitting materials
<p><u>SHIRTS</u> Solid <u>any color</u> .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Long sleeved/short sleeved collared polo-style (i.e. cotton knit, two or three button) shirts ❖ Long sleeved/short sleeved turtleneck shirts ❖ Official PTSA-T-Shirts and sweatshirts for that school ❖ Long sleeved/short sleeved dress shirts or collared blouses ❖ Shirts supporting various school events (sports, student council, teams, ROTC and Scouts uniforms, etc.) as approved by the principal 	<p><u>SHIRTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> Lace, embroidery or other designs ➤ <u>NO</u> Tank Tops, sleeveless shirts, or spaghetti straps ➤ <u>NO</u> Belly/crop tops or exposed midribs ➤ <u>NO</u> Visible brand names or logos except official Schweinfurt School Logo for that school ➤ <u>NO</u> See-through materials ➤ <u>NO</u> Form fitting materials ➤ <u>NO</u> cleavage showing
<p><u>FOOTWEAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Socks – solid <u>any color</u> (no logos showing) ❖ Tights – solid <u>any color</u> ❖ Shoes – sturdy tie, Velcro, buckle or casual shoes to include running shoes (unspecified color) ❖ On occasion, other types of shoes will be allowed by the principal for school performances or ceremonies 	<p><u>FOOTWEAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> Platform shoes ➤ <u>NO</u> Heelies ➤ <u>NO</u> Dress shoes with slick leather soles ➤ <u>NO</u> Heels (shoes must be flat sole) ➤ <u>NO</u> Footwear that has exposed toes or heels (beach wear/slippers/sandals/mules/crocs)
<p><u>SWEATERS, SWEATER VESTS, or SWEAT SHIRTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Solid <u>any color</u> 	<p><u>SWEATERS OR SWEATER VESTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> Windbreaker material worn indoors ➤ <u>NO</u> Hoods worn in the building ➤ <u>NO</u> Potential gang symbols, logos, or patterns
<p><u>P.E. DAY SWEAT SUITS – ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ONLY (Optional) (K-5)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Schweinfurt school logo or solid <u>any color</u> sweatsuits 	<p><u>P.E. DAY SWEAT SUITS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> Sweat suits are to be worn on other days of the week
<p><u>HEAVY COATS, LIGHT JACKETS, RAINCOATS, HATS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ These items can be of <u>any color</u> and can have logos, however, they can only be worn to and from school and at recess. 	<p><u>HEAVY COATS, LIGHT JACKETS, RAINCOATS, HATS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Coats & jackets should not be worn in the classroom (teacher discretion for special cases, such as heating issues.). Raincoats & Hats will not be worn in the classroom .
<p><u>JEWELRY AND OTHER ADORNMENTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ If necklaces are worn, they should be removable during physical activities and cannot be longer than three inches from the neck line ❖ Rings on fingers must be small 	<p><u>JEWELRY AND OTHER ADORNMENTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> Sweat bands or Dog collars ➤ <u>NO</u> Chains to include ones hanging off belts/pants/etc. ➤ <u>NO</u> Hoop earrings or earrings larger/longer than 2 Euro piece ➤ <u>NO</u> Scarves (indoors), unless approved by the principal ➤ <u>NO</u> Gel bracelets ➤ <u>NO</u> Sunglasses worn indoors
<p><u>HAIR AND COSMETICS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Hair- Many hairstyles and cosmetics are acceptable, as long as they are neat, not distracting to others, and do not pose a health or safety risk 	<p><u>HAIR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>NO</u> hair may interfere in the safety of any student at school; hair hanging over the eyes will be secured back ➤ <u>NO</u> Extreme or distracting haircuts, hairstyles, or cosmetics that detract from the learning environment
