MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: 280th Base Support Battalion Snow and Ice Removal Plan

1. References:

- a. AR 420-72, Surfaced Areas, Railroads, and Associated Structures, 28 March 1991.
- b. TM 5-624, Maintenance and Repair of Surfaced Areas, 27 October 1995.
- c. TM 5-627, Maintenance and Trackage, January 1980.
- d. StRSV (City Rule) Cleaning and Safety of Streets/Walkways of Schweinfurt, 17 Dec 91.

2. Purpose: To establish responsibilities and procedures for snow and ice control and removal within the Schweinfurt Military Community.

3. Applicability: These procedures apply to all assigned personnel and tenant organizations in the Schweinfurt Military Community.

4. Alert Plan:

a. The Military Police will monitor the conditions of the roads and will call the Community Operations Center (354-6708) when snow begins to accumulate or when freezing occurs.

b. During duty hours, the Community Operations Center will call the DPW Building and Grounds (B&G) Division (354-6451) to implement snow and ice removal.

c. After duty hours, the Community Operations Center will call the Fire Station (353-8645). The Fire Station will notify the DPW on-call supervisor of the requirement to begin snow & ice removal operations. The DPW on-call supervisor will notify the Chief, B&G Division and responsible contractor to begin snow and ice removal on their assigned areas.

5. Coordinating Instructions:

a. Obtain snow removal hand tools, sand, and gravel from the Self-Help Issue Point, DPW Compound, Building 252 (354-6853).

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b. Keep sidewalks and stairs free of snow and ice and as slip resistant as possible. Remove snow and use sand to improve traction. The uses of salt, ashes, or other corrosive materials are not authorized.

6. RESPONSIBILITIES:

a. Directorate of Public Works (DPW):

(1) Develop, coordinate and execute this Snow and Ice Removal Plan.

(2) Supervise and direct the snow removal contractor for those areas outlined in Annex B.

(3) Execute and supervise snow removal and ice control operations by priority for the areas listed below:

PRIORITY I:

Ledward Barracks, Entrances and Exits  
Conn Barracks, Entrances and Exits  
Access Roads to Dependent School Schweinfurt, Bldg.#505, 509  
All Streets in Housing Area, Askren Manors  
Patton Drive, Conn Barracks  
Gibson and Squires Road, Ledward Barracks  
Ross Street, Hayes Street, and Pedan Street, Ledward Barracks  
Murray Ave and Marne Ave, right and left turns  
Custer Road and Churchill Road, Conn Barracks  
Harmon Boulevard, Conn Barracks  
Tank Road (Heeresstrasse) from Ledward West Gate up to Dittelbrunn  
Taxiway and Airfield  
Railroad Depot in Conn Barracks  
Access Road to Camp Robertson, Massbach  
Access Road to, and roads within former Tac Site, Conn Barracks  
Access Road from the "Werrn-Bridge" to East Gate, Conn Barracks  
Access Road to, and roads within Basic Load Site, Pfaendhausen

PRIORITY II:

All other roads on Conn Barracks, including the Bradley Complex  
All other roads on Ledward Barracks  
Emergency Exit to Highway B19, Conn Barracks

(4) De-icing of the taxiway and airfield on Conn. This will only involve aircraft-safe urea salts and will be done as sparingly as possible so as to preclude pollution of the Conn Barracks water

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supply. Aircraft maintenance, taxiways, and runways must be thoroughly de-iced, however.

b. Provost Marshal:

(1) Monitor road conditions using on-duty patrols.

(2) Notify the COC when road conditions require implementation of this snow and ice removal plan.

c. Community Operations Center (COC):

(1) Maintain liaison with the Military Police for road conditions within the Schweinfurt community.

(2) Notify either the Chief, B&G Division or the Fire Station to initiate the Snow and Ice Removal Plan (see para 4).

d. Tenant Organizations and Units:

(1) Responsible organizations must keep the sidewalks and stairs in the area of the Bradley Inn, Conn Club, Kessler Field Gymnasium/Bowling Center, and the Dispensary must be kept as clean and slip resistant as possible during business hours.

(2) Unit commanders and directors of agencies must ensure execution of snow removal and ice control in the priorities listed below:

PRIORITY I:

Sidewalks and stairs in unit areas  
Hardstands and track parks  
Areas in front of Maintenance Shops

PRIORITY II:

Driveways to buildings  
All other parking areas

e. Building Coordinators and Building Occupants in Residential Areas:

(1) Perform snow removal and ice control on sidewalks and stairs surrounding the buildings prior to 0700 hours each day.

(2) In accordance with German law, perform snow removal and ice control in their areas from 0700 to 2000 hours, seven days a week.

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
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(3) Ensure that snow removal tools and sand are available for use by building occupants.
