SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum #01-03, Exotic Incense (Spice and other cannabinoid mimicking substances)

1. References.

- a. AR 600-85, The Army Substance Abuse Program, dated 2 February 2009.
- b. Federal Register, Vol. 76, No. 46, Rules and Regulations, dated 1 March 2011.
- c. Secretary of the Army Memorandum, Prohibited Substances, dated 10 February 2011.

2. Purpose. To announce the Garrison Commander's policy on Exotic Incense (Spice and other Cannabinoid mimicking substances).

3. Applicability. This Policy applies to all members of the U.S. Forces who have status under the NATO Status of Forces Agreement and their command-sponsored Family members in the U.S. Army Garrison Schweinfurt area of responsibility.

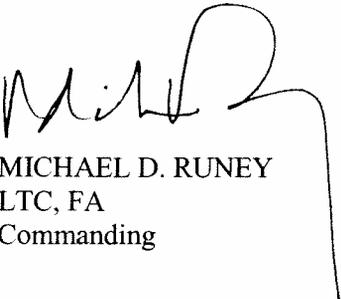
4. Policy.

a. Possession, use or distribution of drug paraphernalia, synthetic marijuana or products that contain exotic incense are prohibited on the US Army Garrison Schweinfurt Installations. All products producing psychoactive effects are prohibited, including its packaging.

b. Synthetic Marijuana, marketed as K2 or Spice, is an herbal substance sold as an incense or smoking material. These products contain one or more synthetic compounds that behave similarly to the primary psychoactive constituent of marijuana, & Delta9-tetrahydrocannabinol or THC.

5. Procedures. Misconduct of any kind may result in Uniform Code of Military Justice action against service members or punitive action against Family members and civilians by the Civilian Misconduct Action Authority. In addition, an Early Return of Dependents or a bar from military installations could be imposed.
