

SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum #01-13, Protection of Military and Civilian Identification Cards

1. References: Army Europe Regulation 600-700, Identification Cards and Individual Logistic Support, 17 July 2002, and USAREUR Regulation 525-13, 12 August 2004.
2. Purpose: To provide responsibility and guidelines for maintaining and protecting Military and Civilian Identification (ID) Cards.
3. Applicability: All Schweinfurt Military Community, Family members, and Civilian personnel.
4. Policy. Terrorism is a crime striking in various forms of threats and violence. As past events have shown, terrorists have reached new levels of organization, sophistication, and violence. One way of preventing terrorist attacks is to safeguard our ID Cards. All ID card holders will ensure the protection of their ID card.
5. Procedures. In accordance with USAREUR Regulation 600-700 individual(s) who lose their ID card will immediately report the loss to the issuing commander and Provost Marshal. Issuing commanders will conduct an inquiry to determine the facts and circumstances surrounding the loss.
