Schweinfurt's combat experts on realities of war

A band of five U.S. Army noncommissioned officers with more than 25 years of deployed combat experience convened at the German infantry school in Hammelburg 30 kilometers down the road to provide their insights on Iraq and Afghanistan to 27 German NCO recruits—all of whom have not been deployed to those areas.

The German soldiers held nothing back with their questions. Do you trust Afghan soldiers, one asked. Do they get the same training as American Soldiers? What types of tactics does the enemy use? Were you ever scared?
