Six months of underwater scuba training culminated in diver certification for five Soldiers from Charlie Company, Warrior Transition Battalion-Europe at a ceremony held on Ledward Barracks.

"It's absolutely been therapeutic, said Sgt. 1st Class Brock Strickland, a wounded Soldier and now certified diver. "It's a tranquil and peaceful experience. When you're under water you don't hear anything except the bubbles coming out of your regulator. And it really puts you at ease and calms you down. You become one with your surroundings."


