For weary high school students of Schweinfurt, the school day begins before reveille echoes across the garrison and before the color guard hoists the American flag high over Andrus Garden in front of the headquarters building. By the time the Soldiers here take morning formation, the 177 high school students of Schweinfurt are already barreling down the A70 autobahn, a grueling day still in front of them.

With a bit of luck and community support, the students may bear a lighter burden next school year. Plans are currently underway to bring a permanent high school to Schweinfurt.
